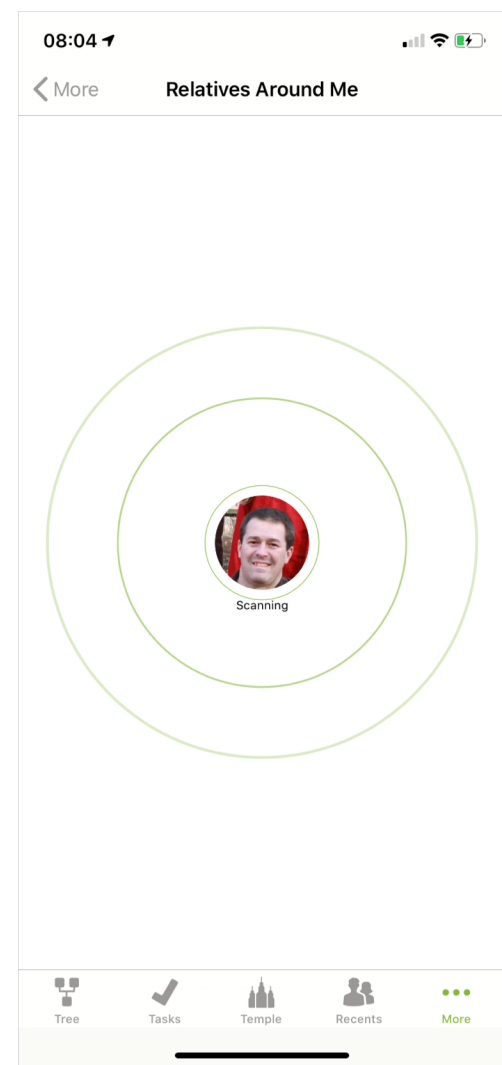

5. Talk to those around you to discuss how you are related

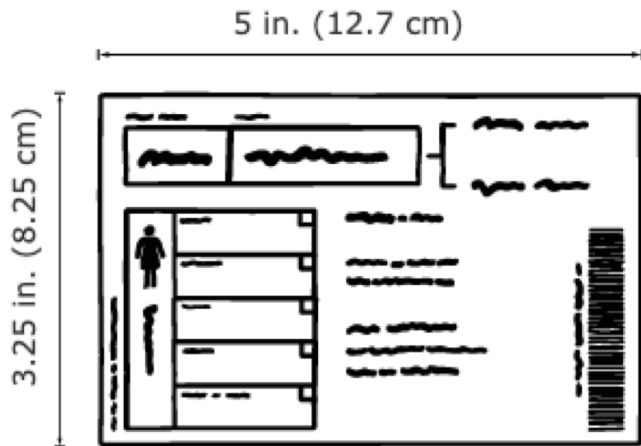


# Submitting Names for Ordinances



# Print Request

Family name cards to be used in the temple will be created on this computer.



## 1. Print

Print on **white paper**. Printer settings should be set to Portrait Layout and Actual Size.

## 2. Prepare

### 1. Print

Print on white paper.

Printer settings should be set to Portrait Layout and Actual Size.

### 2. Prepare

Cut cards and verify size.

3.25 in. by 5 in. (8.25 cm by 12.7 cm).

### 3. Perform

Whenever possible, a couple should be endorsed before being sealed to each other, and parents should be sealed to each other before their children are sealed to them.

### Notification

To improve recording accuracy and to remove pattern wall time, the temple will no longer return cards after your temple visit. You will receive a FamilySearch notification to confirm that the ordinance was recorded.
